George Darrington called the meeting to order. The July minutes were read and approved. The treasurer report was read. The 501c3 has \$3980.00 plus \$1940.22 for playground for a total of \$5920.22. The 501c4 has \$835.65. The report was approved.

The treasurer report differences from this month to last were due to Janice Durfee writing a check to the Post Office for \$41.00 from the 501c4 account. The addition to money for playground equipment in the 501c3 is from the 4th of July lunch. Sadie Udy reported the following expenses for the 4th of July lunch: fried chicken, brownies, macaroni and potato salads from Stokes \$384.07
propane \$15.89
soda pop \$179.70 (on sale at Albertsons)
buns, paper products, condiments, chips, hot dog and hamburger buns from Costco \$308.24
baked beans and a cash box from Walmart \$87.59
cash in box for change \$350.00

We charged \$5 for an adult and \$3 for kids. The profit was \$365.22 plus there was a \$50 donation from Bill and Phyllis Tracy. We fed 150 adults and 50 kids.

George Darrington suggested sending thank yous to those who helped with the dinner.

George asked how the Almo Wild West Days went and Sadie said that there was a horseshoe tournament and a frying pan throwing contest.

Stan Lloyd reported that the fund for the new Elba Almo Road is short \$7000 due to inflation so they will be doing a Phase 4.

It was suggested that we contact Kimberly Ottley to come to the September meeting and report on their playground fundraiser to let us know what they would do differently. George will contact her. It was suggested to e-mail about the meetings a week in advance.

Tom Harper is still working on the sign.

Jay Goodwin suggested that we put signs in the store, Outpost, and City of Rocks for donations towards the playground.

George suggested that we have a time frame and modify expenses and to ask the Bishop if the church could donate any money since they use the park facilities.
