Minutes from Last Meeting. The September minutes were read and approved.

Playground Equipment. Brenda Davis explained that the Logan, Utah company could deliver and install the chosen playground equipment this coming Saturday if we could get permission from Larry Edwards and Nancy Ward to allow the installation. They gave their approval and after a group discussion, decided to install the new equipment near the existing swings and slides.

More discussion concerning the state of the large slide did not result in agreement about an appropriate course of action. The slide is damaged and many folks think that even if fixed, it is too steep. Nancy and Larry maintained that numerous people liked the slide and that it was needed for the older kids. Larry agreed that it did need some repair work. Other options were proposed, including adding on a slide to the new equipment that the older kids would enjoy and remove the existing large slide.
