The Cache Peak Civic Association has received no response to correspondence dated May 16, 2007, concerning requests for information about activities at the Castle Rocks State Park. Letters were sent to your office as well as Senator Darrington, Representative Bedke, Mr. Sangrey, Mr. Williams, Mr. Taylor, Cassia County Commissioners and Mr. Keck.

The Cache Peak Civic Association will be meeting on Thursday, June 7, 2007, at 7:30 PM at the Cache Peak Emergency Services Building. We again request that a representative from the Idaho Parks and Recreation Department be present at that meeting and would appreciate a prompt response to our request.

Our request is a simple one. We want a knowledgeable person to attend our CPCA meeting and honestly answer our questions. We feel that we have a right to know the intentions of the IDPR/Castle Rocks State Park management concerning the construction of the "Bunkhouse" motel unit at the Castle Rocks.

We have the right to know what type of facility is being planned and we will NOT wait until an open house when plans are finalized and construction is ready to begin before we find out.

Open communication between the Park and the community would seem to be an important concern and even an obligation for Park management. We expect a prompt reply and representation at the June 7th meeting.
