We are disappointed that you declined our invitation to attend the Cache Peak Civic Association meeting. The Association members and other residents of the community have many questions about development at the Castle Rocks Ranch State Park that we want to have addressed. The fact that an open house is to be held in the future has no relevance. You say that the plans are being discussed and that no decision has yet been made. We insist that as residents and businesses owners in the local community we have the right to be informed of the plans which are being discussed, what architectural drawings have already been completed as well as any other issue concerning the Park.

The Cache Peak Civic Association has been established by local residents to address the needs of the local community. Our mission statement and bylaws include involvement in local government activities that affect individuals and businesses in our community. The Cache Peak Civic Association provides a forum for discussion and problem solving for the entire community, including those who do not belong to the Association.
